Cluster Meetings: Rev. Dr. Richard Speck and Marylin Huff (UUCDC) convened a cluster interest meeting on October 5, 2013 to explore the possibility of reforming a Greater Philly Cluster of Congregations. The response was positive and delegates from all 13 congregations have participated on subsequent meetings approximately every 6 weeks facilitated by Marylin Huff.
